Kevin Pina, an American journalist based in Port-au-Prince, has been one of the very few sources of critical reporting on the recent political crisis in Haiti (see his articles at zmag.org).

Kevin is on a speaking tour of the US and Canada, and will be presenting his 30 minute documentary film, “Haiti: The Betrayal of Democracy”. With this film, and a presentation following, Kevin will be highlighting the terrible social cost of the US-sponsored coup d’état that removed the elected Haitian president, Jean-Bertrand Aristide, from office in February 2004.
